Key Meeting Action/Discussion Highlights	
Oral Health Collaborative (OHC)	<p>Candace Roney updated the committee regarding the Oral Health Collaborative.</p> <p>The Santa Clara County Public Health Department is planning a county wide assessment for dental needs and gaps. Funds from Prop 56 will be used to address these dental needs and gaps in the county.</p> <p>The next meeting has been postponed to March 6 from 3 pm to 5 pm. Ms. Roney will send meeting invites to the email list.</p>
Give Kids a Smile 2018	<p>Michael Tran reported to the committee on Give Kids a Smile.</p> <p>Most of the tally sheets have been received except from a few schools and B&G Clubs. Once all the sheets are received, Michael will tally the data and give it to Dr. Monica Wu and Dr. Sarah Murray for the GKAS presentation at the April GMM.</p> <p>The committee discussed potential thank you gifts for GKAS dentist volunteers. There was a discussion on whether a perpetual plaque should be given to long time GKAs volunteers or continue with the thank you letter and certificate. The committee looked into other possible gifts such as gift certificates, frames, shirts, hats, and pins as possible gifts. Michael will review the proposed gifts with Candace and ask what the volunteers would prefer afterwards.</p> <p>Ms. Roney proposed for GKAS 2019, to hold the event not on the same week as the February GMM. Proposals included the same days of the week (Wednesday, Thursday and Friday), but during</p>

Michael will check with the school districts if the proposed GKAS 2019 dates works for them.</p> <p>For the poster contest, the deadline of March 31, 2018 was chosen for schools to submit the posters to SCCDS. A GKAS Task force was formed to decide the poster contest finalists. The TF members are Drs. Monica Wu, Sarah Murray, Augie Lagemann, Jennifer Yau, and Tiffany Giang. The poster contests finalists will be presented at the April GMM for other members to vote on the winners.</p> <p>Dr. Monica Wu will draft a GKAS survey for dentists and nurses on for SurveyMonkey and Michael will distribute it.</p>
<p>Give Seniors a Smile (GSAS)</p>	<p>Dr. Sarah Murray updated the committee about GSAS. Several dentists along with Society staff visited the Live Oak Adult Day Care Center. Ms. Colleen Hudgens, the director at Live Oak is open to having Dental Society dentists do oral/dental screenings and oral health education to seniors at Live Oak.</p> <p>The committee reviewed the oral cancer screening form, the survey for caregivers, and the denture care instructions. The committee will update the forms based on feedback received from Dr. Barghouth and Dr. Call.</p> <p>The committee decided on April 25 from 9 am to 12 pm would be good date and time for the volunteer dentists to come to Live Oak and perform oral cancer screenings.</p> <p>Michael will confirm the date and time with Live Oak. Michael will order oral cancer brochures from the ADA.</p>
<p>Fluoride Varnish (FV) Program</p>	<p>Michael Tran reported on the FV program. Moreland School District was not interested in the program at this time.</p> <p>The committee proposed dates for the next FV program: May 3rd for Lynhaven and May 8th for Rosemary.</p> <p>Michael will reach out to the district nurse to see if these dates work for the schools.</p>
<p>Healthy Living Fair - April 22</p>	<p>Michael Tran reported that volunteers for the Fair have to be TB tested. The proposal for the committee to cover the TB testing fees was turned down by the committee. Dentists have their own insurance which covers the TB testing. This issue with eh TB testing is inconvenience since testing takes two days.</p> <p>Michael will contact Tzu Chi if they would help cover the TB testing for all other volunteers.</p>

<p>Foothill Oral Cancer Walk</p>	<p>Dr. Monica Wu said the committee will not be involved with the Cancer Walk due to low participation from members in the past. Members can still make their own donations and participate in the walk. SCCDS will still promote the walk in the magazine and the GMM to bring awareness to the oral cancer.</p> <p>Ms. Roney will check if the oral cancer walk could be a SCCDF event.</p>
